<p><i>Literacy</i> Children will: Take part in rhythm, rhyme and alliteration activities. Become aware of individual letters and their sounds through the 'Letters and Sounds' scheme. Work towards forming recognisable letters correctly, especially those in their name.</p>	<p><i>Maths</i> Children will: Compare objects by size, height, weight and capacity. Become more aware of the passing of time. Identify and describe some properties of 2d and 3d shapes in the environment. Begin practical addition and subtraction activities using up to 10 objects.</p>
<p><i>Communication and Language</i> Children will: Develop their confidence and their questioning and explanation skills. Retell and re-enact known stories in sequence and make up their own stories.</p>	<p><i>Physical Development</i> Children will: Increase their scissor skills and develop their ability to hold writing/drawing tools with the tripod grip. Become more aware to move with confidence, imagination and safety.</p>
<p><i>Personal, social and emotional development</i> Children will: Become more aware of the needs of others and appreciate the help people give them.</p>	<p><i>Understanding the World</i> Children will: Learn about seasonal changes from winter to spring. Learn about the Arctic Experiment and observe freezing and melting processes. Explore how all living things need to be looked after. Develop an awareness of other cultures Learn about the solar system</p>
<p><i>Expressive Arts and Design</i> Children will: Explore colour, shape, shape and texture in two and three dimensions working individually and collaboratively. Develop their imaginative play and the retelling of stories using puppets and role-play props.</p>	<p><i>Religious Education</i> Children will: Through the 'Come and See' programme explore the topics: 'Community-Celebrating' - 'Eucharist-Gathering' - Lent/Easter-Growing'.</p>
<p><i>ICT</i> Children will Learn to use the mouse to play and change games on the computer with increased independence.</p>	<p><i>Music</i> Children will Learn new songs relating to our topics. Play with percussion instruments and explore patterns and rhythms.</p>
