Year 1 Curriculum Overview 2017-18 – Spring Term



RE

Special People – The children will learn that there are special people in our lives who are there to help.

Meals – The children will learn that the parish family gathers for the Eucharist (Mass), Jesus' special meal.

Change – The children will learn that Lent is a time to change in preparation for the celebration of Easter. Change is a necessary part of healthy growth.

Other Faiths

Hinduism – Through different stories, the children will learn about Hinduism and the ways people worship.

English

- Stories about fantasy worlds

Mathematics

- To understand place value in two-digit numbers
- Read and write numerals to 20 and beyond
- Relate addition to counting on and to combining groups.
- Relate subtraction to taking away and to counting back
- Use equipment to measure objects
- Show information in lists, pictures, tables, block graphs and pictograms
- Time – read and record the time to hour.

Science

Polar Adventure – In this unit the children will learn to: – name animals that are birds, fish and mammals, –name animals that are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. –know which materials are waterproof, transparent, translucent, opaque and flexible, –group materials that are waterproof, transparent, translucent, opaque and flexible.

Treasure Island– In this unit the children will learn to: – name different plants and animals, –be able to name animals such as fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, –describe what fish are like compared to humans and other animals, –know why we need to protect ourselves from the Sun, –know about some properties of materials.
