This is an overview of your child's curriculum throughout this term:

Topics: "All About Me"/Colours/People Who Help Me/Senses/Mr Men/Autumn/Christmas

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| <p>Literacy Children will: Be encouraged to participate during story time to develop their vocabulary and their imagination. Learn to recognise their name. Begin to learn phonics using the 'Letters and Sounds' scheme. Take a library book home each week.</p> | <p>Mathematics Children will: Learn to join in with counting rhymes. Say, use and recognise numbers from 0-10+. Learn the name of 2d shapes and begin to describe them using mathematical language. Develop their understanding of positional language. Learn to sort objects by size, shape and colour. Explore capacity through sand, water and cooking activities.</p> |
| <p>Communication and Language Children will: Develop their speaking and listening skills during every day routines in school. Have daily 'activities and games to develop their vocabulary. Begin to develop their questioning skills and explanation skills through class activities.</p> | <p>Physical Development Children will: Have opportunities to develop their fine and gross motor skills by exploring space inside and out. Use a range of large and small equipment to increase their hand-eye coordination and gross and fine motor skills. Use malleable materials such as play dough, sand and corn flour. Learn to use and handle classroom equipment and tools with safety and care.</p> |
| <p>Personal, social and emotional development Children will: Settle into nursery routines and begin to form good relationships with adults and peers. Learn to share and take turns with others. Learn to find their way around the nursery and build their confidence to try something new. Learn to tidy away equipment appropriately and look after our resources. Look after their personal hygiene with more independence. Learn our nursery rules and be supported to follow them with growing independence. Learn about different feelings and emotions.</p> | <p>Understanding the world Children will: Explore their own growth and have opportunities to talk about themselves and their families. Learn about their senses and explore them through many practical activities. Learn about other cultures through our 'All About Me' topic. Explore, sort and experiment with a range of different materials. Have many opportunities to build and construct. Learn about changes in seasons and will discover and learn about the signs of Autumn. They will learn about 'Christmas Around the World'.</p> |
| <p>Expressive arts and design Children will: Use a variety of mark making tools and resources Explore materials in 2D and 3D forms. Have opportunities to develop their painting and drawing skills. Develop their imagination and creativity through role play opportunities that are closely linked to our topics. Provide their own ideas for role play areas and resources and will develop these with adult support.</p> | <p>RE Children will: explore these topics: Myself, Welcome and Birthday through the 'Come and See' programme They will: Make the sign of the cross and learn simple prayers and hymns. Learn about the importance of their names, about belonging to a family and how God knows and loves each one of us. Learn about Baptism being a welcome for a new baby to God's family. Learn what about what a 'welcome' is. Learn what a birthday is and they will explore what it means to get ready for a birthday. Learn about Advent, being a time to get ready for Jesus' birthday at Christmas. Learn about other faiths- Diwali and Hanukkah</p> |
| <p>ICT Children will Learn to use a variety of digital equipment to support their learning and develop mouse control during ICT activities.</p> | <p>Music Children will: Learn new songs relating to topics Learn to play familiar percussion instruments.</p> |
