Year 2 Curriculum Map – First Half Term

Traction Man and Flat Stanley visit St Bede's

English	<p>English</p> <p>Our focus texts this half term will be Traction Man and Flat Stanley, next half term we will be focussing on Winters Child and Coming Home;</p> <p>The children will be exploring the techniques to create their own adventure story. They will learn to draft, edit and polish their writing for each topic.</p>
Maths	<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>In Maths lessons the children will be looking at the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Partitioning numbers in different ways.● Writing number sentences using the symbols +, −, ×, ÷ and =● Symmetry● Estimate whether a container holds more or less than a litre.● Tell the time when it is quarter past, half past or quarter to the hour● Fractions●
Science	<p>In Autumn 1 the children will be exploring the 'uses of everyday materials, next half term we will be linking our science topic 'All living things and their habitats' with Coming Home/Winters Child. We will be linking this to our English topics.</p>



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Design Technology	and	<u>Design and Technology/Art</u> The children will be designing their very own Traction Man outfit based on the story they are creating in English. We will be exploring what materials the outfits should be made of (linked to Science) they will plan their outfits, edit their plans, create their costumes and evaluate their costumes.
P.E		The children will be creating their own Traction Man Circuit training/Assault Courses, thinking about ways to stay healthy. They will also be having the winter Olympics at St Bede's during the second half term.
R.E.		<u>New Beginnings</u> We will be looking at our own New Beginnings and those that are experienced within the Bible. <u>Signs and Symbols</u> We will be look at the various signs and symbols that are common place in our faith. <u>Preparations</u> In the run up to the advent season will be looking at preparation and how we prepare for the variety of different experiences that we will encounter.
