Thought for The Week

The Power of Reading

An interesting article was published last week by UCL Institute of Education quoting researchers at the Centre for Longitudinal Studies . They found that teenagers who read in their spare time know 26% more words than those who never read. They also found that teenagers from book loving homes knew 42% more words than their peers who had grown up with few books. The more words a child knows, the better they understand the world around them.

It really does underscore the line that ***those who read succeed.***
