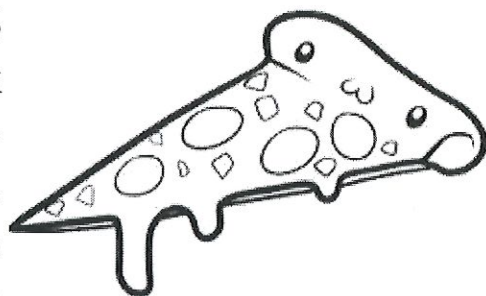

TUTORING/ CLUBS

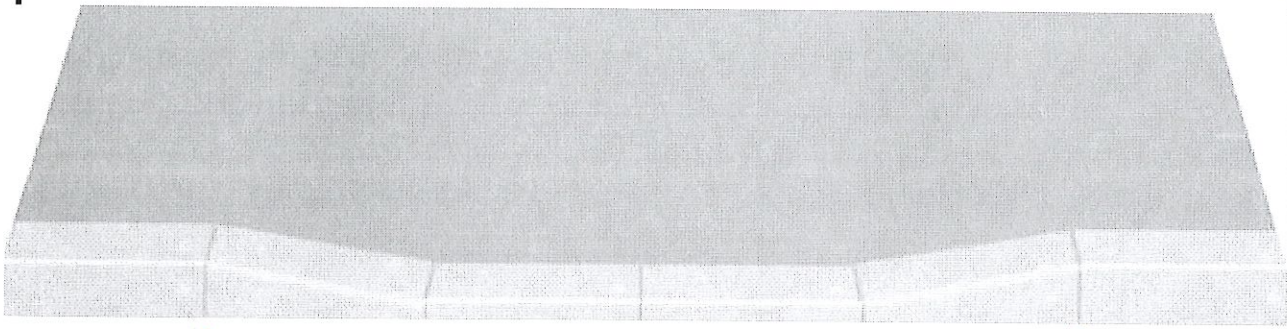
The last tutoring sessions take place next week. New clubs begin the week beginning 11th June. Names have been drawn from a hat!
