First Aid

In a typical day, we have fifteen to twenty children visit First Aid, that's up to a hundred each week. In the majority of cases, this is for something minor—a grazed knee etc. In more serious cases, we would phone you the parent to make you aware—sometimes asking you to come into school. Sometimes an injury sustained at lunchtime in the playground, which improves after First Aid, may worsen during the course of the afternoon and we rely upon the children then to bring this to our attention. If a child complains of being unwell during the afternoon, the first thing an adult will ask them is have they been to First Aid earlier that day. In future, whenever a child comes to First Aid they will be given a green wristband so you can talk to them at the end of the day about what happened. Bumped heads are different. There is a orange wrist band and we will always text you to let you know about a bumped head. If the bump is more serious, you will be telephoned by the Office.
