Dear Family



RE: We are continuing our topic on 'Good news'. Thank you for sending in the bees and butterflies and sharing your child's good news. Our 'flower' is looking good! As May is the month of Mary we are saying the rosary during prayer time. We are using one set of 10 rosary beads each day, saying 'Mary our Mother, pray for us' for each bead and then the 'Hail Mary' Your child is welcome to bring in their own rosary beads from home to use at prayer time if they would like to. Thank you to those children who have already brought their rosary in.



Mini beasts: This week we have continued our mini beast topic by talking about and making spiders.



Life-cycles: This week we have continued our Mini Beasts topic. We have been to see the eggs in Reception again. We are all awaiting excitedly to see the chicks!!! Thank you for returning your slips and your donation. Without your donation it would not be possible for the children to have this wonderful experience.



Road Safety: Next week we will begin to learn about road safety. We will talk about walking on the roads safely and we will set up a roadway course in the outdoor area.



Literacy: We have listened to 'The Very Busy Spider' story which the children loved. We introduced the letter sounds 'm' and 'd' this week and we have also re-capped on the letter sounds-'s,a,t,p,i,n'. Please continue to emphasise these initial letter sounds through objects at home.



Bug Club: This is an on-line reading club where your children are able to access books for you to read to your children. Please remember to read these books with your child. Their login details for Bug Club is in the back of their yellow library record book. If you are having problems please let us know.

Maths: We have been talking about symmetry again this week while making spiders. We talked about the spider having 8 legs with 4 legs on each side of his body. They have also been practising writing numbers and forming them correctly.



Physical: We have had lots of activities outside this week. The children have enjoyed building, painting, drawing, climbing, riding the bikes and scooter, playing with the water and digging in the mud. All these activities help to strengthen their physical development.



Lanterns of the week: This week's 'Lantern of the Week' in our morning session are Victoria and Jeremiah. 'Lantern of the Week' in our afternoon session are Ryan and Zikora. Well done to all of them for trying hard in their activities, being a kind friend and for helping in the nursery this week



Library Books: Please remember to return your child's school library book in their book bag on Thursday. Thank you.



Show and Tell: Some children like to bring toys from home to show us. As we don't want them to get forgotten, lost or broken we have now introduced a 'Show and Tell' time. If your child would like to bring in a toy on a Thursday to show to the children and talk about it, please can you ensure their name is on it and we shall have a box for them to put it in. This activity can improve your child's confidence and speaking skills. Please can you discourage your child from bringing in toys on the other days. Thank you.
