The children had their photographs taken on Wednesday and they were all superstars. Well done!

The children have had a lovely week celebrating 'Anti-Bullying' week and exploring the colour 'Purple'.



Anti-Bullying Week: This week we have been celebrating 'Anti-Bullying Week'. The theme this year is 'All Different, All Equal' In School we have been looking at ways to show kindness to others. We have been listening to stories and making masks. Thank you for supporting 'Anti-Bullying' week by encouraging your child to wear odd socks today.



Topic: Colours: Thank you for sending purple objects to use with our song 'What is...?'. The children have enjoyed creating lovely purple pictures and practising colour mixing with different shades of red and blue to make purple butterfly prints.

Pink Week Next week will be 'pink' week and children are welcome to bring something pink.



RE: We have continued learning through our 'welcome' topic. We have also been talking about being good friends through our 'Anti-bullying' week.



Weekly Liturgy: Today children from Reception came to the nursery to join us for our weekly shared Liturgy. We shared the Lantern of the week diaries with all the children and it was lovely to see their faces as we read their news.



Literacy: We have listened to more stories on Bug Club and the children have enjoyed discussing them. Please remember to use Bug Club at home. The children have also been practising tracing, copying and/or writing their name.

Maths: The children counted toys into two groups, counted each group and then counted them all to see how many they had altogether. We have used the words 'addition', 'add', 'altogether', and 'plus'. This is good practise for when your child goes to Reception and it is easy to play at home.



Physical: We have been developing the children's fine motor skills by encouraging them to hold their pencil correctly while tracing, copying and /or writing their name on their work. Please continue to do this at home with their name cards. Thank you.



Lanterns of the week: This week's 'Lanterns of the Week' in our morning session are Eiran and Enoch. 'Lanterns of the Week' in our afternoon session are Anastazia and Bartosz. Well done to all of them for trying hard in their activities, being a kind friend and for helping in the nursery this week
