We will also be reading stories about Mary. If your child would like to bring in some Rosary beads with them next week, they are very welcome to. **BLUE:** Next week we will be investigating the colour blue. Your child is welcome to bring in something blue from home to share with us. Please ensure their name is on their object, thank you.



**Literacy:**

We have been sharing stories this week and some of the children have loved listening to traditional stories on the 'Busy Things' web-site.



**Maths:**

We have begun singing various number rhymes and completing number and shape puzzles. We have also been sorting coloured objects into pots and counting them as we do. We read the story 'One Gorilla-A magical kind of counting book' and have begun some artwork for a display in the maths area.



**Physical:**

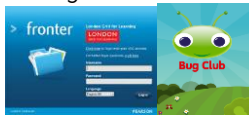
