Dear Family




**RE:** We are continuing our topic on 'Good News'. Thank you for sending in the bees and butterflies and sharing your child's good news. Our 'flower' is looking good! As May is the month of Mary we are saying the rosary during prayer time. We are using one set of 10 rosary beads each day, saying 'Mary our Mother, pray for us' for each bead and then the 'Hail Mary'. Your child is welcome to bring in their own rosary beads from home to use at prayer time if they would like to. Thank you to those children who have already bought their rosary in.



**Literacy:** This week we have continued practising writing our names and trying to form the letters correctly. Please remember to keep practising at home. Thank you. We have learnt 2 new sounds - 'i' and 'n' this week and we have used sound fans to try to find the different sounds 's', 'a', 't', 'p', 'i', and 'n'. The children have tried to make vc and cvc words with them, such as, 'at', 'in', 'is', and 'sat', 'pit' and 'tap'.



**Bug Club:** This is an on-line reading club where your children are able to access books for you to read to your children. Please remember to read these books with your child. Their login details for Bug Club is in the back of their yellow library record book. If you are having problems please let us know.

**Maths:**  This week we have been practising naming and describing 2d and 3d shapes. We also talked about where we can see these shapes in the environment. We have used number fans to find numbers to 9 and then we tried to make some numbers to 20 using 2 number cards! The children are very good.



**Life-cycles:** This week we have continued our Mini Beasts topic. We have been to see the eggs in Reception again. We are all awaiting excitedly to see the chicks!!! Thank you for returning your slips and your donation. Without your donation it would not be possible for the children to have this wonderful experience.



**Physical:** We have been practising holding the pencil correctly while writing our name. We have used play dough to practise prodding, squeezing, rolling and squashing it to 'dough disco'. Please see the attached sheet which will inform you of the benefits of doing 'dough disco'. All these activities help their fine motor skills.



**Lanterns of the week:** This week's 'Lantern of the Week' in our morning session are Martine and Zachariah. 'Lantern of the Week' in our afternoon session are Elethea and Anay. Well done to all of them for trying hard in their activities, being a kind friend and for helping in the nursery this week
