

Charlie & Year 3 Explore the Chocolate Factory

English:

Charlie and the Chocolate Factory & Ice Palace

Through watching the film adaption of Roald Dahl's Charlie and the Chocolate factory, children will plan to draft, edit and polish a piece of narrative writing and a set of instructions. Children will then be exploring their senses, expanding their knowledge of imagery and creative writing through recounts. They will have the chance to share their writing every three weeks during their Time to Shine writing lesson.

Mathematics:

Maths lessons this term will focus on mental maths, securing number facts, problem solving and arithmetic with a focus on place value and partitioning numbers.

Religious Education:

Homes & Promises

Children will learn that God is present in every home understand that love binds a family together through joys and sorrows. Children will be exploring the groups they belong to, what it means to make a promise and how they can help others keep their promises.

Science:

Rocks & Food and our Bodies

Children will be carrying out experiments on rocks. This topic will teach the children the properties of rocks, its uses, soil and fossils. Children will learn about where animals get their food from as well as the human skeleton.

PSHE:

Our Happy School & Out and About

The children will create ground rules to establish a constructive learning environment. Children will learn to develop responsibility for being safe in various situations.

French:

Bonjour! & En Classe

Children will learn how to greet others, introduce themselves and use the first 10 numbers. Children will be identifying objects in the classroom and colours, as well as give their age and respond to instructions.

Music & ICT

During the autumn term children will be investigating rhythmic patterns, descriptive sounds and graphic score.

Children will be learning about e-safety and how they can stay safe whilst online. The children will also be learning how to send emails safely.
