

## **SPORTS PREMIUM FUNDING - Highlights of 2018/19 funding**

Total Funding 2019/20 financial year: £19,500

Anticipated expenditure: £21,500

Total Funding 2018/19 financial year: £19,550

Total Expenditure: £24,900

- Contribution towards the Premier League School sports scheme – a professional PE coach comes into school one day a week for the whole of the academic year and, and for the duration of each term works alongside class teachers to deliver age appropriate football training and a module from the scheme of work..
- Continued professional development for teaching staff through team teaching with expert coaches.
- Swimming for all year 5 children
- All children who wanted to attend a sports club across all year groups in the school have had the opportunity to do
- All children from year 1 to year 6 to visit an outdoor excursion centre for a day of activities including go karts, orienteering, assault course and archery.
- All children to compete in revamped sports day with all children participating in all events.

### **Future Improvements.**

- Attend professional sporting event- either as a whole school event or sign posting parents to appropriate opportunities.
- Continue to offer equal opportunities to all year groups across the school.
- House football/competitive sport within year 5 and year 6. Both boys and girls will compete in a range of different sports.
- Interschool competitions – look to arrange inter school competitions with other schools. Focus on competitive activities and competition. Look at arranging sports days and “days of excellence” where children to be given chance to excel.
- Pupil Premium children will be offered a guaranteed place in any club that they wish to attend.

### **Sustainability**

Continuity in provision so the same coach/es will work with the children.

Outside and additional opportunities signposted to all parents so children can continue with the activity.

All staff contribute fully to deciding how, and where the grant should be spent.

Grant shared between outside providers and resources so activities and opportunities can continue into the new school year.

### **Participation and Attainment**

All children across the school have received specialised coaching.

All children across the school have had extra opportunities, outside of the minimum statutory requirements, to participate in a range of sports.

All children who asked to attend a multiskills or football after school club throughout the school year had the opportunity to do so.
