

Highlights of 2016/17 funding

Total Funding: £9,800

Total Anticipated Expenditure: £12,500

- Contribution towards the Premier League School sports scheme – a professional PE coach comes into school one day a week for the whole of the academic year and, and for the duration of each term works alongside class teachers to deliver age appropriate football training and a module from the scheme of work.
- All children have the opportunity to attend a sports club outside of timetabled PE lessons.
- Streamlined afterschool clubs with the same coach to ensure continuity in the high quality sport sessions.
- Continued professional development for teaching staff through team teaching with an expert coach.
- Swimming for all year 5 children
- All children who wanted to attend a sports club across all year groups in the school have had the opportunity to do so.
