

French

Pupils will use 'Je peux' followed by an infinitive verb to tell us what they can do. They will engage in short conversations using their sentences to practice punctuation.

PSHE

The children will have discussions about upcoming changes and how they feel about change. They will explore coping strategies to deal with their feelings.

Geography

The children will study the South-Western UK coastline and make comparisons to coastlines abroad as well as using geographical language to describe features of the coast.

Science

Pupils will identify different magnets, explain what magnetic fields are and the law of attraction as well as making comparisons.

RE

The children will continue Hinduism and move onto the topic of Choices exploring the stories of the Two Sons and the Prodigal Son, then onto Journey in Love.

English

The children will be focusing on a novel called The Windrush Child. This text will inspire our writing styles; a biography and newspaper report.

Maths

In Maths the children will continue to spin arithmetic plates and introduce chunking to solve divisions. Pupils will explore interpreting and presenting data.

Music

The children will relate sounds to actions, emotions and images., use musical vocabulary to explain opinions and compose and perform in a group.

Computing

Children will plan and record a podcast using digital tools to edit, by combining sounds and effects as well as learning how sounds can be stored digitally.

Art

.In Art, the children will be developing an understanding of shading and drawing techniques to create botanical inspired drawings.

PE

Children will work through a series of activities which challenge their teamwork, trust, communication, co-operation and problem solving skills in small and large groups.
