#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will know:

- what it means to be a class 'helper';
- the class rules;

Children will be able to:

- build relationships with adults and peers;
- share and tidy away equipment in the class;
- take responsibility for materials and resources;
- follow the class rules with minimal prompting;
- put on an apron and coat independently;
- demonstrate a developing sense of responsibility;
- find solutions to conflicts and rivalries;

#### Communication and Language

Children will know:

- vocabulary for everyday routines in school;

Children will be able to:

- use questioning skills during classroom activities;
- use explanation skills during classroom activities;
- demonstrate a developing vocabulary during every day routines;
- retell the story once they have developed a deep understanding;
- ask questions to find out more information;
- listen carefully and understand why listening is important;

#### Physical Development

Children will know:

- different skills to enhance their ball play;

Children will be able to:

- use their bodies to travel in different ways;
- use a range of large and small equipment;
- demonstrate an improvement in their hand-eye coordination through the use of pencils, paintbrushes and scissors;
- use classroom equipment and tools safely and with care;
- use different styles of movement to manoeuvre across the apparatus;
- how to be aware of space between themselves and others;
- use different tools to enhance an outcome;

#### Literacy

Children will know:

- print conveys meaning;
- their name begins with a capital letter;
- s, a, t, p, i, n: letters and sounds;
- to read text from left to right and top to bottom;

Children will be able to:

- take part in story time;
- discuss characters the encounter during story time;
- being to ask questions about books they read;
- use their letter knowledge in their early writing;

#### Maths

Children will know:

- numbers to 20;
- the 'one more than/one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers;
- some 2D and 3D shape names;
- patterns can be found all around us;

Children will be able to:

- count objects, actions and sounds;
- count verbally to 20 and beyond;
- make groups of 2, 3, 4 and 5;
- subitise numbers up to 5;
- continue, copy and create repeating patterns;

Children will know:

- that we are all different;
