

### RE

In our RE lessons, children will be able to talk about what it meant for the Israelites leaving Egypt & their trust in God; the signs & symbols of Passover and create their own version of the Shema. Use developing religious vocabulary; give reasons why Christians show love & service as they wait hopefully for the coming of Christ; engage with & make response to questions about the coming of Christ & make links between scripture texts showing how the people of God waited purposefully with hope for the Messiah.

### Maths

In our Maths lessons, children will be able to continue to work on their skills in the four operations whilst using place value, fractions, decimals and percentages.

### English

In our English lessons, children will be using the poem The Highwayman as our focus text to inspire our writing styles; a monologue and a biography.

### Science

In our Science lessons, children will be able to take measurements using a range of scientific equipment with increasing accuracy; investigate chemical changes and identify scientific evidence that has been used to support or refute ideas or arguments.

### PSHE

In our PSHE lessons, children will be able to discuss self esteem; talk about puberty & how it is a natural process; express how they feel about those changes, whilst appreciating how amazing it is and develop confidence that they can cope with changes/.

### Computing

In our Computing lessons, children will be able to use (if) statements; use variables in programs; write and amend more complex programs; test, debug & refine programs.

### PE
