English

We are looking at the different parts of the water cycle and how it impacts and influences how rivers are formed.

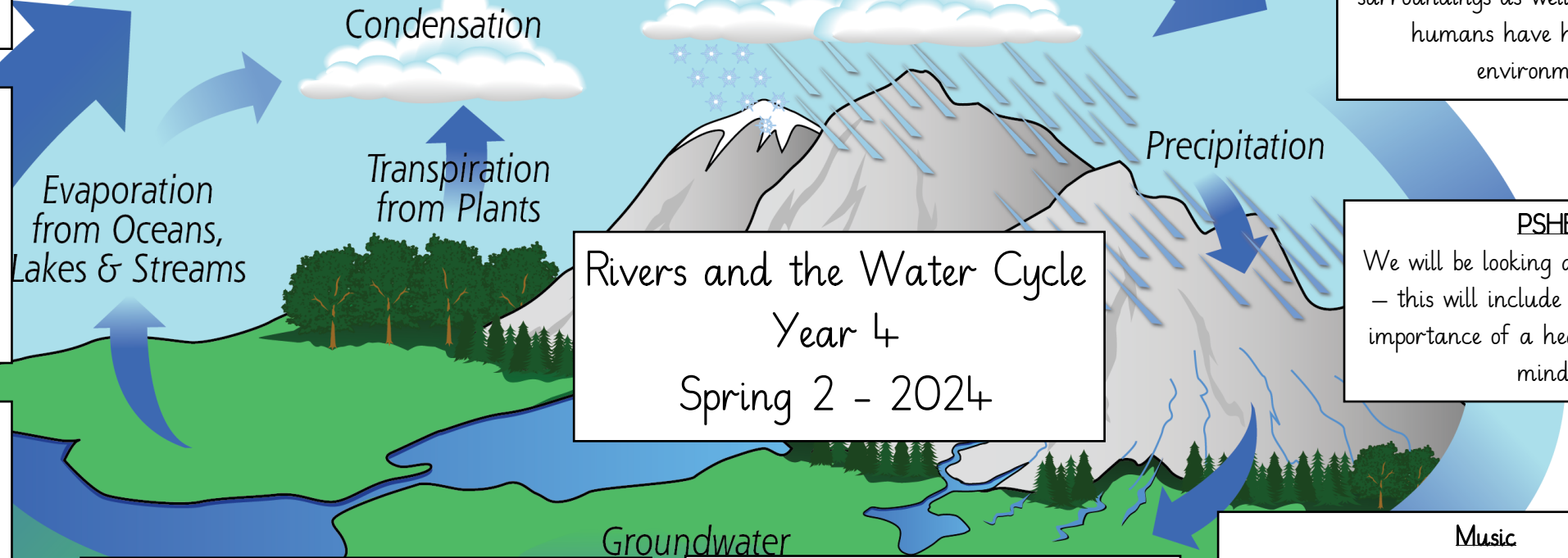
Computing
