We will recap written methods of addition, division, multiplication and subtraction. We will look fractions, ratios and measurement.

### English

We will use the story 'The Windrush Child' to help develop skills in writing a newspaper report and biography.

### RE

We will explore the stories of the Two Sons and the Prodigal Son and special places for Jesus. We will look at how we can ask for forgiveness.

### Science

We will perform simple tests to discover how magnets have different uses. We will also explore what magnetic fields are and the law of attraction.

### PSHE

We will explore how our bodies change as we grow. We will think about how we can manage our feelings and express emotions during times of change.

### Geography

We will look at geographical vocabulary to describe the coast and look at some of the effects of the sea and tide. We will also think about activities that occur in coastal areas of the UK.
