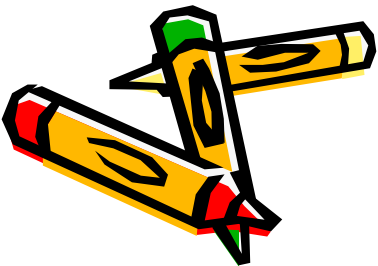


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Induction

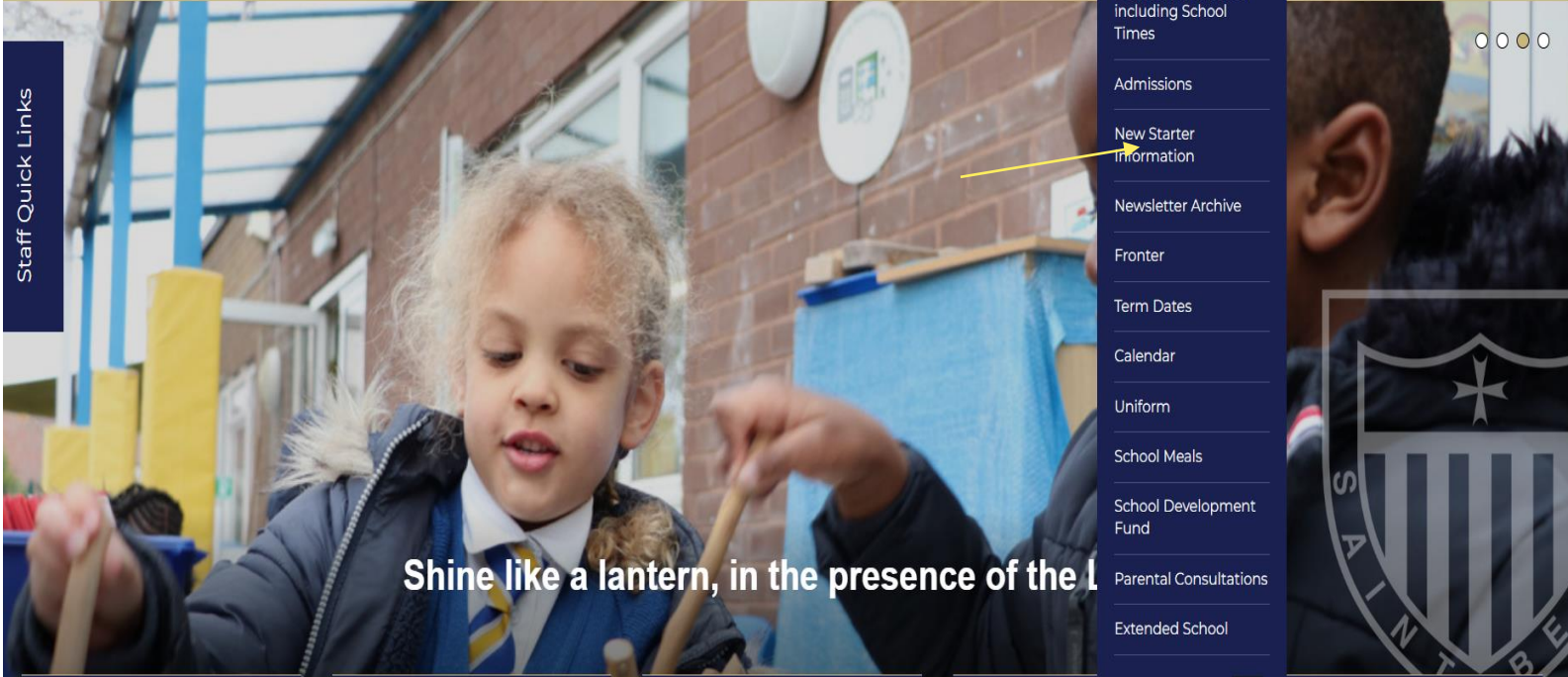

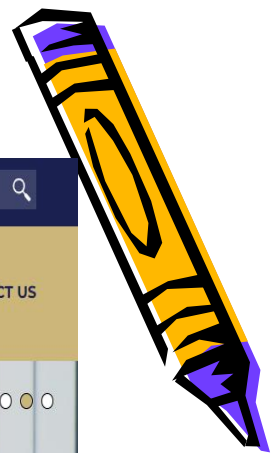

Induction

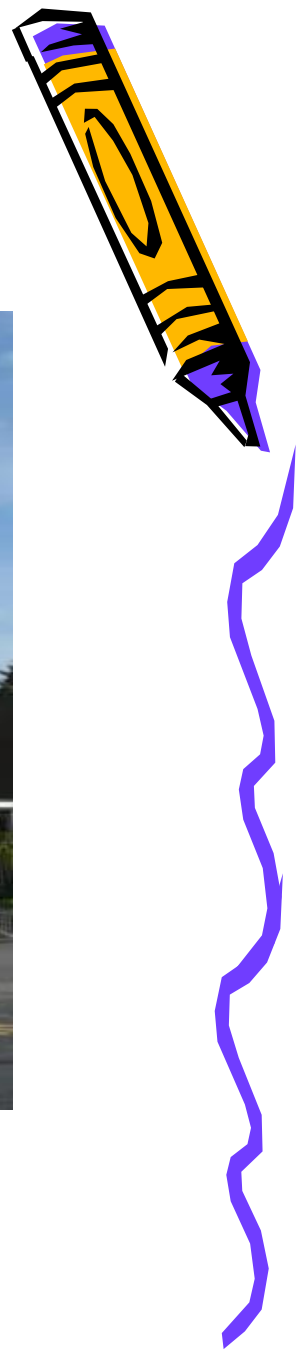

Reception School DayTimes

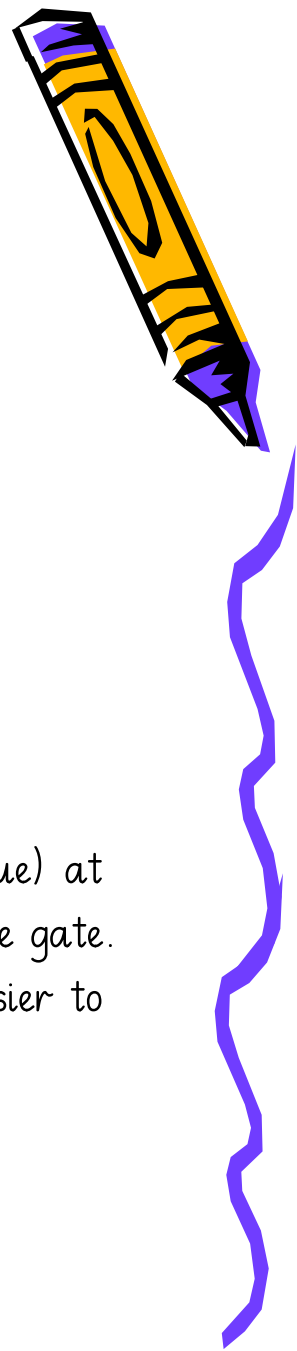

Children are required to be in school on time and to be collected on time.

We are asking for you to collect your child from the front gate (Canon Avenue) at the end of each day. It is better for the children if we all leave from the same gate.

The front gate has been chosen as it is quieter and the children will find it easier to see you from there.



Uniform



Children in Reception are expected to follow the uniform policy. You can find the details for our uniform on the school website – **Parents – Uniform – Uniform information booklet**. During the warmer weather your child may wear shorts. We ask for your child to wear shoes that have a **velcro** fastening. We do not allow unusual hairstyles (e.g. tram lines/steps/stripes/motifs/ Mohawks/Mohicans/coloured hair extensions etc). Beads are not permitted in any part of the hair. All hair (in any style) that is longer than the length of the shirt collar must be completely tied back at all times. Hairbands, hair ties, small ribbons (no diamantes or other decoration) and clips must be plain white, royal or navy blue. Hair bows must be small – we do not allow oversized bows embellished with decorations/diamantes).



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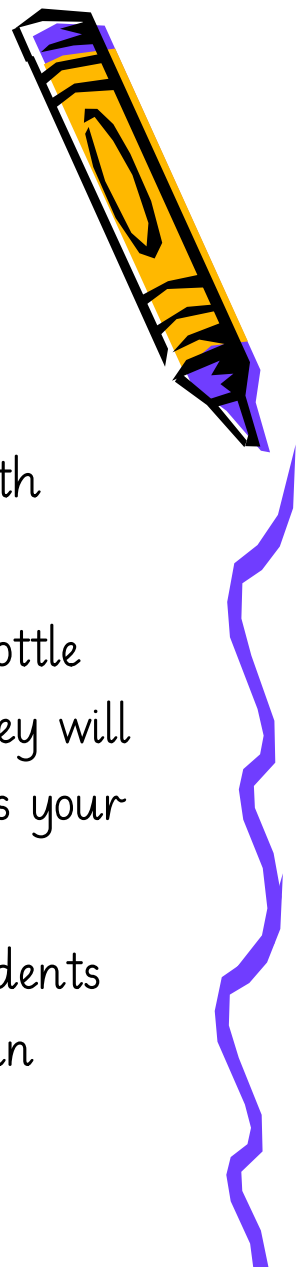


Uniform

- We are asking for you to provide your child with a pair of wellington boots and a rain mac/all in one.
- Please ensure that every item of uniform is **clearly** labelled with **your child's name**.
- Please purchase a St Bede's book bag and a sports cap water bottle for your child. If your child will be having a packed lunch they will need a packed lunch bag, please ensure all bags and bottles has your child's name on.
- Your child will need some spare uniform in case of any accidents (toileting or getting wet at the water table). These will be kept in school and in a bag provided by yourself.



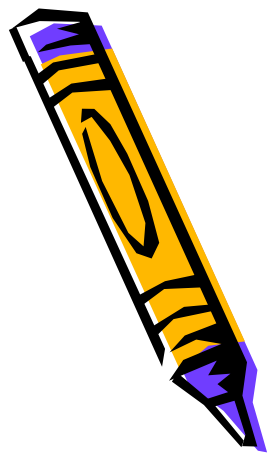
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Absence

Early Years Foundation Stage



The Early Years Foundation Stage guidelines aim to provide:

- Quality and consistency in the early years.
- A secure foundation through learning opportunities tailored to the needs of pupils of this age group.
- Partnership working between parents and practitioners.
- Equality of opportunity to support children of all backgrounds.



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Early Years Curriculum

There are seven areas of learning and development in the early years, they are:

- Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)
- Communication and Language (C&L)
- Physical Development (PD)
- Literacy (L)
- Mathematics (M)
- Understanding of the World (UOW)
- Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)



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Early Learning Goals

The early learning goals are what your child will be working towards throughout the year. The Government's expectations are that your child will achieve these by the end of the year.

We aim to provide a rich curriculum that will adhere to the children's interest and will provide them with opportunities to enhance their learning through exploration and engagement.



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Personal, Social and Emotional



Together we will learn how to talk about our emotions, how to share, how to take turns, how to care for one another and how to be respectful of one another. We will learn about how to be healthy and stay healthy.



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Communication and Language



Together we will learn how to listen to one another, share our ideas and understanding. How to express our thoughts and feelings. Offer explanations on why things may happen and make predictions about stories we engage with. It is all about the vocabulary we use through our everyday communication.



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Physical Development



This is where your child will develop their gross motor and fine motor skills. Your child will engage with weekly PE lessons. They will be encouraged to a range of small tools, for example: scissors, paint brushes and cutlery.



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Literacy



Your child will have the opportunity to explore a wide range of books. Each week they will bring home a reading book and library book to share with you. They will also have access to areas for mark making both indoor and out doors. The children will engage with daily phonics lessons. Our aim is for your child to be able to write simple sentences independently by the end of the year.



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Maths



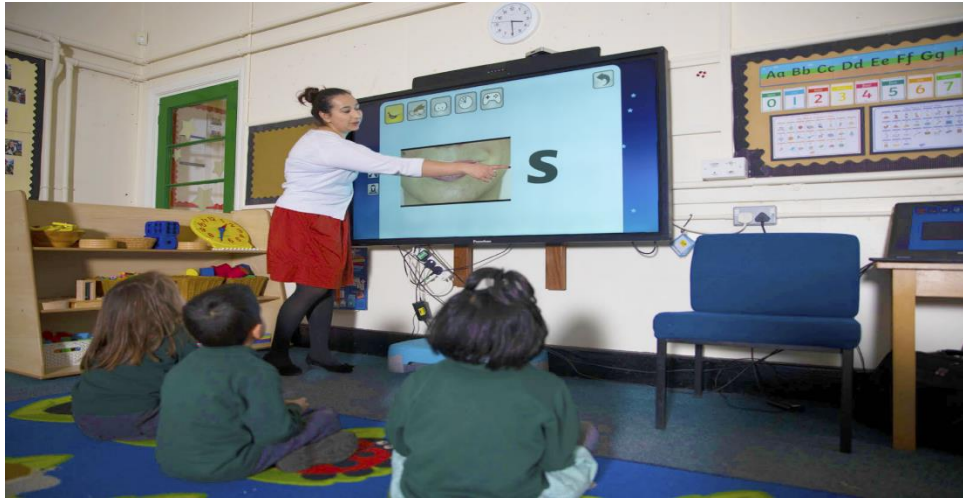
Maths in the early years is all about hands on experiences along with learning number rhymes/songs. Children learn by doing and exploring which they are encouraged to do so. We will provide many opportunities for your child to explore, both indoors and outdoors. Maths resources can be found all around our learning environment.



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Phonics



Your child will join in with daily phonics sessions. They will learn how to listen for initial sounds, blend the sounds to read words and to use their sound knowledge to write words. Each week you will be informed of all the sounds we have learnt. We use the Twinkl phonics scheme.



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Understanding of the world



Together we will explore the natural world around us. We will learn how to care for our plants and animals. We will learn about the changes in the seasons. We will talk about people who are special to us and we will learn about our local community.



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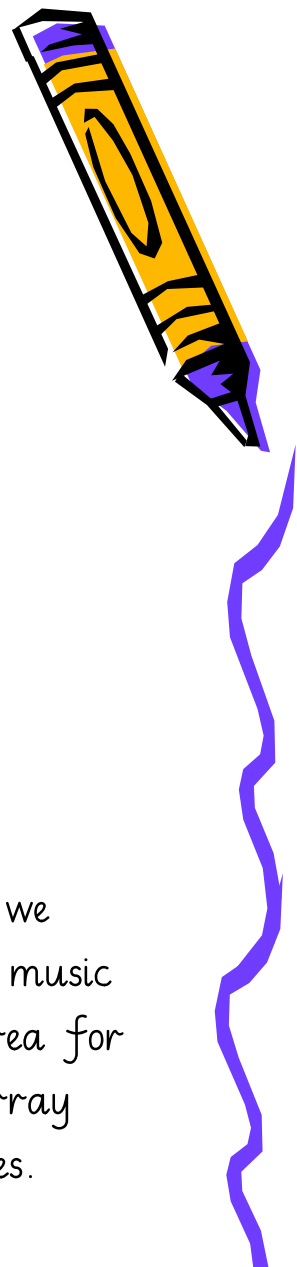
Expressive Arts and Design



Expressive arts is not just about painting and drawing, In reception, we engage with learning new songs, how to move to different types of music as well as using musical instruments. Each class has a role play area for the children to engage with. The children also have access to an array of small world resources where they can create their own story lines.



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Assessments

Reception children are required to take part in the Government Baseline assessment. This has to be completed in the first 6 weeks of being in school.

The children will take part in half termly assessments, this enables us to see where interventions are needed.

Your child will not even realise they are being tested.



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Communication



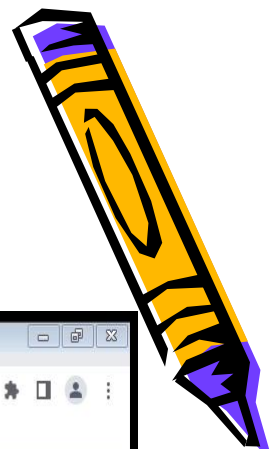
- Mr Nott provides a weekly newsletter which will be emailed to you directly.

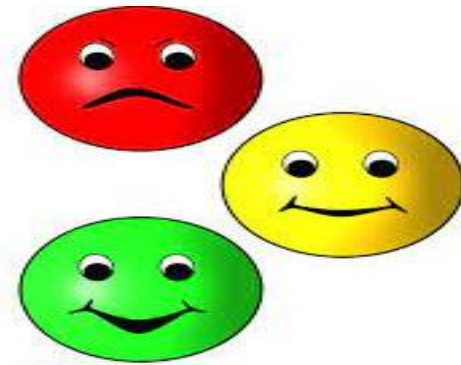

Rewards

In Reception, we use the traffic light system. If your child ends the day on Freddy frog they will receive a sticker. Throughout the year children will receive certificates for their different achievements. We believe in praising the children, this enables them to have the feeling of success. In the spring term we will introduce the children to Lantern of the week. Each week two children are rewarded for their achievements with a certificate.



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Lunches

If your child would prefer a packed lunch we ask you to not fill their lunch bag with lots of food. You will find that many children will find this quite daunting as they do not know what to eat first. Please ensure that the lunches are healthy – NO CHOCOLATE, FIZZY DRINKS, JUICE OR SWEETS. WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL. During the school day your child will have access to fruit and milk during snack time.

Toileting



Coming into Reception your child **should be toilet trained**. However, toileting accidents can happen through out the day. If your child has an accident they will then change into their spare uniform. The children have access to the classroom toilets and will be encouraged/reminded to go.

If for any reason your child is **not yet toilet trained** can you please let us know. There is still the 6 weeks to encourage your child to start their toilet training.



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Medical



If your child has any medical needs you will need to.....

- Inform us about their medical needs.
- Make sure your child has any required medication in school. This needs to be brought in on their first day of school.
- Speak to our school's SENDCO lead so that we can put a plan into place for your child.

We have a school nurse who we are in contact with so if you have any concerns please let us know.

Any other form of needs please let us know so that we can support both you and your child during your time here with us at St Bede's.



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School Trips



As a school we like to provide the children with the opportunity to participate on a school trip with their peers. The trips are educational and are linked to the curriculum.

For us to be able to go on a trip we do ask for a contribution. We do try our best to keep the cost down. To enable you to pay for the cost of a trip you will be provided with a login to the online payment system where you are able to pay for the trip when you can. We will provide you with information of the trip as soon as we can.
